

COVID-19 Precaution Kit Inventory List

Prepare this kit to have on hand for use with residents with suspected or confirmed COVID-19. Store the completed kit in a secure location (e.g. the Team Leaders office). The kit will be implemented when the resident is in an isolation room while waiting for test results or with confirmed cases. When implemented, the designated CRMA will ensure the Kit is fully stocked at the start of each shift. The Kit should be placed just outside the isolation room door, in the hallway, against the wall.

1. Signs for Door – post the following signs to the resident isolation rooms

2. [PPE Sequencing Guide](#) – post this guide to the resident room or attach to the Precaution Cart/Bin with the Kit supplies
3. 10 Long-Sleeve Disposable Gowns
4. 10 Surgical Masks. Employees fitted for N95s should use those in place of surgical masks.
5. 1 Box Gloves
6. 10 Face Shields or 2 Pairs of Goggles
7. 1 Bottle Hand Sanitizer
8. 1 Box Alcohol Wipes
9. 3 Trash Bins (open trash bins without lids)
 - Place two trash bins with liners inside the resident room. Label one “Disposable PPE: Gowns & Gloves” and label the second “Reusable PPE: Face Shields”.
 - Place the third bin with a liner outside the resident’s room, next to the Precaution Cart/Bin. Label the third trash bin “Disposable PPE: Surgical Masks”
